Re: Irma Debris Removal

We received the note below from the Manatee County Solid Waste Collections Supervisor. While this note still does not provide us with a specific schedule for Hurricane Irma Debris pick-up, it does indicate that collection is beginning for the private communities in Manatee County.

I have exchanged many phone calls/emails with county employees over the past 7 & 1/2 weeks since Irma. Although, this is the most positive official information that I have received, the bottom line is that we have no schedule when they will actually arrive.

Our gate has been informed that they will be allowed entry for debris pick-up <u>24/7</u>. As they previously stated, they will only pick up **curbside** plant debris.
