They want to avoid any further damage to the lawns, which are far too soggy. They have a plan to do a special two-step mowing job once they can safely access the lawns again.

You may have also noticed that the excessive rains have affected the flowers planted throughout River Wilderness. The pentas, the impatiens, and more have died. We have to wait to replace those so you may see the dead flowers being pulled out and those areas left bare until we can safely replant something that can withstand these extremes.
