I got this from the Census website: "Address canvassing improves and refines the Census Bureau's address list of households nationwide, which is necessary to deliver invitations to respond to the census. The address list plays a vital role in ensuring a complete and accurate count of everyone living in the United States."

They are going to be active in River Wilderness over the next several weeks and apparently they started today. They have a badge identifying themselves as part of the Census.

Keep in mind this address canvassing is just one step of the Census. The next step will involve us filling out the actual census survey once we receive the mailing going out to every home.
