Re: RW HOA April 21 Election and Ballots

The ballots for the upcoming River Wilderness HOA Board of Directors election were mailed this week and have already been received by many in our community. Quite a few of our snowbirds have already returned to their out of state residences and should be receiving their ballots very soon.

Over the past few years we have had a large number of residents turn in their ballots on election night. In light of the current Corona Virus concerns, and to continue to promote social distancing for your safety and the safety of all our residents and Argus staff, I strongly recommend you fill out your ballots and proxy now. Follow the instructions included on Page 1 in the packet. A summary is as follows:

1. Vote for only three (3) homeowner candidates.
2. Place the Blue voting ballot in the Inner Blue Ballot envelope. Place the Inner Blue Ballot envelope into the Outer Blue envelope (addressed to Argus). You must sign the Outer envelope where indicated at the top left corner for it to be a valid ballot. You will also need to provide your address where indicated at the top left of the Outer envelope.
3. The Board recommends you vote YES to roll-over any year-end surplus. Mark your vote, then please sign, date and fill in your address on the White General Proxy.
4. Since attendance will be limited due to the COVID-19 restrictions, it is important that you MAIL in the Substitution of Proxy ONLY to establish a Quorum for the meeting. You will not need to attend the meeting. Please assign David Kelley (Secretary) as your proxy. Please sign and date the White Substitution of Proxy sheet. Place the White Substitution of Proxy sheet and White General Proxy in the White envelope. You must sign the White envelope where indicated at the top left corner for it to be a valid. You will also need to provide your address where indicated at the top left of the White envelope.

Don't wait until the last minute - MAIL your ballot and proxy in the self-addressed envelopes via the US Postal Service now!
