Re: Mandatory Evacuation Level A

Dear Residents,

Manatee County just issued a MANDATORY evacuation for Level A (refer to my previous email today with the descriptions of the Levels and the applicability to your home location) and a VOLUNTARY Level B effective 8 am, Tuesday, September 27, 2022.

The Foundation had planned to close the Ft. Hamer security entrance to Visitors Tuesday evening, however based on the mandatory evacuation, we will be closing the Ft. Hamer gate at 8 am Tuesday morning to visitors. Residents will still be able to access this gate. The security gate will be maintained operational until winds go to 35 mph, at which point the gates will be opened at both the Ft. Hamer and Old Tampa gates.

However, if a storm surge does happen, **DO NOT DRIVE THROUGH WATER!**

The guard at the Ft. Hamer gate will leave the gate at 8 am tomorrow morning and go to the Old Tampa gate and assist with any increase in traffic accessing the community. Again, this gate will remain operational until winds reach 35 mph, at which point, ALL Entrance gates will be placed in Open Status, as per Manatee County guidelines. At this point, the guards will then be dismissed from their stations to go home.

If you need any help with preparation, do not hesitate to reach out to your neighbors. Time is of essence.
