NEW RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF THE FORT HAMER GATE EFFECTIVE THURSDAY, DECEMBER 8, 2022

As you are aware, only River Wilderness residents, Islands' residents, visitors and guests of Islands' residents, and contractors, construction and delivery vehicles servicing the Islands and its residents are allowed to enter our community through the Ft. Hamer gate. Starting on Thursday, December 8th, the same restrictions will apply to those leaving our community through the Fort Hamer gate, i.e., only River Wilderness residents, Islands' residents, visitors and guests of Islands' residents, and contractors, construction and delivery vehicles servicing the Islands and its residents will be able to exit through the Fort Hamer gate.

All visitors and guests of non-Islands' residents, as well as contractors, construction and delivery vehicles servicing non-Islands' residents, must enter and exit through the visitor entrance at the Old

Tampa Road gate. Also, golfers who are not residents of River Wilderness or the Islands must use the Old Tampa Road gate for ingress and egress regardless of whether they have a barcode or not.

Non-residents who are permitted to enter the Fort Hamer gate, i.e., visitors and guests of Islands' residents, and contractors, construction and delivery vehicles servicing the Islands and its residents, shall secure a "day pass" from the security guard indicating that entry was made through the Fort Hamer gate. These non-residents, to exit the community through the Fort Hamer gate, must approach the left of the two exit gates whereupon they will return their "day pass" to the guard (or show their driver's license to prove they are a resident of River Wilderness or the Islands without a barcode) to gain egress. If the "day pass" does not indicate that entrance was initially made through the Ft. Hamer gate, they will be turned around and required to exit through the Old Tampa Road gate.
