Re: Vultures Roosting Near Savannah Lakes and The Islands

Dear Residents,

Last evening during our RW Master Association Board Meeting we were provided an update by residents in the Savannah Lakes area as to Vultures roosting near the marsh by and in Tract 802. Members of the board inspected this area and verified this was the case.

We had spoken with the US Department of Agriculture yesterday also, who verified that “hazing” which is comprised of a variety of methods including shooting fireworks (not at but near) the vultures, and shining lasers on their feathers in the evening are legal methods to discourage roosting.

If you hear fireworks in the next few evenings, be aware we are utilizing this tactic to discourage roosting.

We will continue to evaluate and more closely utilize the USDA if needed, should these methods prove useless.
