Dear Residents,

**This communication supersedes all previous asphalt restoration communications.** We apologize for the typographical errors and inconsistencies between dates.

Please note that two areas in the Islands have been switched to allow access to the community center for an upcoming board meeting.

We understand that no matter when this work is scheduled it will cause inconvenience to the residents of the areas that are being worked on. We ask you to make the necessary preparations and take precautions as you drive through the areas, respecting the workers as they apply the coatings to our roads. We thank you in advance for your cooperation.

**Instead of the residents applying the sand to their driveways, we have have arranged for Asphalt Restoration Technology to apply the sand to each driveway after they apply the coating to ensure proper application of the protective sand.**

The following is a synopsis of details that will help to make this project a success. You will also notice links to 2 documents with a map and corrected dates for the services, and a document (with dates

corrected) from the company with some helpful information.

7. The contractor will be applying sand on all driveways for driveway protection at the proper time.

8. Please review the revised map for the corrected treatment dates.

9. **The Fort Hamer Gate will be closed from 6am on December 13 until 2pm**
