Re: Road Rejuvenation Status Update

Dear Residents,

We are almost done with Phase I. The guard gate at Ft. Hamer remains closed until noon tomorrow (December 15), to minimize tracking on the pavers at this entrance. The roads themselves are now open, although there have been some hiccups! Cones were moved within the Islands before the roads were officially opened, and, as a result, there are tire track marks visible on the pavers within the Islands community.

The good news is that we expect those tire track marks to fade over several months. The bad news is that the chemicals were supposed to soak in undisturbed and minimize track marks. This was not allowed to happen.

In the Islands we also had a truck drive rapidly and recklessly throughout the community over the bridges and the roundabout twice in a row, almost losing control of the vehicle and hitting our two volunteer road committee members and some of the road staff. This behavior was inexcusable and dangerous. We will be addressing this behavior with the identified resident. The River Wilderness community is better than this. It is always just a few that make the bad name for the entire community.

The Asphalt Restoration Team will be returning to stripe the roads

where applicable. Please make every effort to show our roads committee and the roads staff the respect necessary to ensure the striping goes off without a hitch.
