The Eat Beat

Looking for a venue to celebrate a special occasion? Or maybe you want to stop for dinner before an evening at the Straz Center for the Performing Arts? Or you might be looking for a special restaurant after enjoying an afternoon stroll on the Tampa Riverwalk. Regardless of the reason **Ulele's** is the answer. Located at 1810 N. Highland in Tampa the words 'special', 'unique' and 'one of a kind' are good attempts at describing this eatery. As described on the Ulele website: 'Ulele (pronounced You-lay-lee) celebrates the vibrant fusion of ingredients from Florida waters and land once home to many Native Americans, including the young princess Ulele. Expect intricately flavored, visually appealing dishes prepared on the 10' diameter barbacoa grill. On Tampa's Riverwalk.' You must go to the Ulele website to check out the menu where they offer a variety of seafood dishes, seven different steaks, pork chops, chicken, fried duck entrees along with a number of vegetarian and gluten free dishes. Also, for those that care about such things, note that there is a Ulele Spring Brewery on the premises. And while you're navigating the website check out the park-like setting; it's really that nice! I am sure that after you visit Ulele's you will agree that it's special, unique and one of a kind. Website: <http://www.ulele.com/>

If you are not inclined to travel to Tampa for a special dinner but you are in the mood for a micro-brewery beer you might try the **Oak and Stone** at 5405 University Parkway, University Park (my GPS got all confused with this address; restaurant is on north/west corner of University and Honore, in front of Staples). Their specialty is Artisan Pizza. The personal pizzas include The Garden (kale pesto, broccoli, feta, artichoke and mozzarella), the Gluten Free Greek (similar to

The Garden but it has gluten free crust) and the Clucker (garlic spinach, goat cheese, pine nuts, balsamic and roasted garlic sauce). If the pizzas don't meet your dining needs (not a big surprise!) did I mention that they also have BBQ Pork Sliders, meat loaf, pasta, burgers and tacos? If you enjoy a beer they will give you an 'account bracelet' and let you draw your own beverage from a wall of about 35 tappers! Wow! Website: <https://www.oakandstone.com/>
