Re: Hammocks Meeting Notice

The new CDC guidance is no gathering of over 10 people. In compliance with this guidance and concern for our residents health, the Hammocks Board has cancelled the regular Board meeting on March 26. We also have a Special Meeting scheduled on March 26 to vote on whether to allow asphalt shingles roofs in addition to the current tile roofs. Rather than postpone the Special Meeting and vote, we are implementing a new procedure that will be in compliance with the new guidance.

If you have already mailed your ballot and proxy to Justin at Argus, you do not need to do anything else. If you plan to bring your ballot to the meeting, you will be met at the door by a Hammocks Board member, you will be allowed inside to drop off your ballot, and then leave the building. If you wish, you can wait outside the building while Justin counts the ballots. You should wait away from the door so residents that want to drop off a ballot are not blocked from entering. While you wait, please practice good social distancing and stand in groups of less than 10, with each group at least 10 feet apart. Once Justin has completed counting he or a Board member will announce the results to anyone that has waited. The Board will announce the results the next day.
