CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation will begin construction on the Interstate 75 (I-75) at US 301 interchange to provide improvements to the interchange including improvements to and around the I-75/US 301 interchange in order to improve highway operations, safety, and regional mobility.

Improvements include:

- Reconstruction of the US 301 interchange converting from a partial cloverleaf design to a diamond interchange design
- Replacement and widening of interstate entrance and exit ramps
- New bridges over the Manatee River for a northbound exit ramp and a southbound entrance ramp
- Construct noise walls at designated locations
- Widen I-75 to provide 8-lanes
- Intersection improvements at: 51st Avenue East 60th Avenue East 19th Street East
- Bicycle and sidewalk improvements

This project is a Design-Build contract, meaning FDOT will award the final design and construction to a single bidder. Oftentimes, the bidder is a partnership between an engineering firm (design) and a contractor (builder).

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Advertisement for design-build proposal late 2019
- Bid price proposals opened mid 2020
- Construction late 2020/early 2021

PROJECT COST

Construction costs are estimated at \$145 M

PROJECT CONTRACTOR

A contractor will be selected in Summer 2020.
