Day 1 – Staging

I arrived on site today at 6:30 a.m. and met up with my employee to get my cart and stored it at the golf course with the permission of Pat Walsh from the Pro Shop. I also met with Joe Taylor over at the maintenance shed and he allowed us to store the milling machine and the Port O Potty in their yard!



I met with Grady from Superior at 7:45 a.m. and showed him both the staging area at the maintenance shed as well as the location off of Little Country Road. He decided for the first part of milling, staging at the maintenance shed would be best and once we finish Woodland Fern, we will then store the equipment off of Little Country Road. This will save hours on transporting back and forth!

The M.O.T. crew installed the "Gutter Buddies" in all the drains being affected by the milling and paving project. I am aware that we are scheduled to have beautiful weather and no rain however the gutter buddies are designed to prevent any debris from blowing in and clogging the drains, not just water runoff. They



were finished with the installation by 11:15 a.m.

The milling machine arrived on site at 12:00 p.m. and everyone was off site by 1:00 p.m. We were hoping to get the Port O Potty today as well as the sweepers, but they were on another site and not expected here until after 5:00 p.m. I felt delivering tomorrow would be fine since the milling machine was here already.
