River Wilderness Day 4 - Milling

I arrived on site today at 6:30 a.m. with the milling and cleaning crew arriving between 6:20 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. There were two incidents that occurred today that caused a delay of game with the first one being a manhole that was sacrificed to the asphalt Gods. This is a very common occurrence and a company has been called and the manhole will be fixed tomorrow morning. Please be careful when driving on Wilderness Blvd. East near this area as it is only wide enough for one vehicle to pass safely.





The second issue was the milling machine felt horrible about the damage and quit working and we swapped out machines. Anyone near the area during the change understood the difficulty of loading and unloading two milling machines on the same road! CRAZY! The milling crew was off site by 5:00 p.m. and I left site at 5:15 p.m.

Because of the two delays of project, we did all of Laurel Oak Lane but still need to clean up the ends but were unable to complete the final pass of milling on Wilderness Blvd. East from Little Country Road to the north Lakeside Circle intersection but feel confident the crew will pick up the excess tomorrow along with Old Orchard cul-desac and all of Lakeside Circle if all goes well.



There is some debris left in the roadway and the pavement is uneven so PLEASE be very safe in this area. The debris will affect the friction course and you will not have the same stopping power you had with the original roadway.

I would rather take you around the community then have someone pass out. You delaying me is nothing compared to the delay the fire department, police and ambulances cause!

I MUST give a HUGE virtual hug and shout out to **Liz Kelly on Wilderness Blvd. East** for her generous offering of cold sodas and drinks for the crew.....ALL OF THEM! She is even one of the houses that was near the manhole cover! The crew was greatly appreciative of the gift and talked about how nice you were to even think of them! YOU ROCK!!!!
